Students are responsible for supplying their own sleeping bag and pillow slip.

NB Please pack lunch and a snack for the first day in a small backpack or bag.

CLOTHING (Please name ALL clothing)

- 1 coat - windproof, lightweight, warm - parka
- 2 quick drying t-shirts
- Pair jeans/tracksuit
- 2 pair shorts
- 2 pair socks
- 1 windcheater/jumper
- Pyjamas
- 2 changes of underwear
- Sunhat **and** beanie
- Thongs
- 1 pair of runners
- 1 pair of shoes for canoeing – Note: these may get wet
- A set of old clothes to wear during the canoeing activity.



PERSONAL TOILET NEEDS

- 1 towel (not too thick as they take too long to dry)
- Face washer and toilet bag, soap and container, toothbrush and toothpaste

OTHER ARTICLES

- Torch
- Drink bottle
- Camera (optional - child is responsible)
- Plastic bag (for used clothing)
- Roll-on personal insect repellent - not aerosol
- Sunscreen
- Pencil case
- Travel games (no electronic games)
