



Grade 6 Excursion Immigration Museum, Friday, 25th August, 2017

Dear Parents,

On Friday, 25th August the Grade 6s will be going on an excursion to the Immigration Museum.

As part of the 'finding out' phase of our inquiry unit, Australian Immigration in the 20th Century, students will be participating in the Passport Plus program at the Immigration Museum. Students are invited to uncover the migration stories contained in a collection of suitcases. Students work in teams to unpack the suitcases and develop a profile of the migrant whose belongings they discover. At the end of the session, teams present their findings to the class. Following this staff led session, students are presented with their Passport, which they use to guide them through the museum galleries. The gallery experience provides students with the opportunity to extend the understandings established in the suitcase activity.

The cost of this excursion is \$12.00 and is covered by the excursion levy.

We will travel to the Immigration Museum by train. Students need to be at Frankston Train station by 8.30am. All students need to be taken by private car to Frankston Station and accompanied by a parent onto the platform. Parents will need to collect and sign off students from the Station Car Park (opposite TAFE) at 3.30pm.

All students are to wear full uniform. They will need their snack, lunch and water bottle in labelled disposable bags, as the museum cannot hold school bags.

We will require two parents per grade to help us on this day. If you are interested could you please indicate on the form below.
