Our class did an online survey called 'Survey Maker' and the highest percentage was Sensory Playgrounds with a smashing 69%.

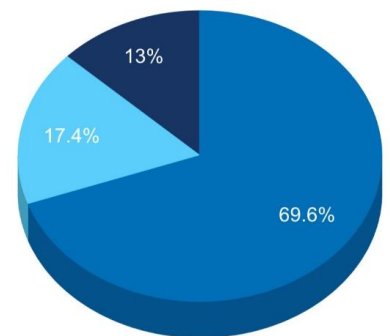
What playground improvement project do you think would be most valuable and why?
