As you are aware, in Term 3 our Prep students investigated, 'What is a Living World?' We will require **two parent volunteers per class** to join us on the day. The volunteers must also have a current **Working With Children Check** and be **double vaccinated** that has been sighted by MEPS office staff. Please indicate your availability to volunteer on the permission slip. Please return your consent form by Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2021. Volunteers will be notified if they are required to attend after the cut-off date for the return of permission slips.

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## **Prep Myuna Farm Excursion – Living Things on the Farm**

### **Student Behaviour**

'I understand that in the event of my child's misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home.
