YEAR 5 NOTICE

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to be offering Year 3 – 5 students the opportunity to participate in the first MEPS Swimming Event.

The purpose of this day will be threefold; firstly and foremost, it is to encourage all students to participate and have a go. Secondly, there will be a focus on water safety which many students missed out on this year due to swimming lessons being cancelled. Thirdly, it will take the place of the early morning swim trials that are normally held in the second week of the new school year, this will hopefully also help MEPS present a larger team for District Swimming in 2022.

The Year 3 – 5 Swimming Event will be held on **Thursday, 25th November at The Pines Aquatic Centre in Frankston**. We will be departing MEPS by bus at **9.30 am** and returning to school at **2.00 pm**.

Over the past few years, the State Government has provided schools with a “Swimming in Schools” grant with the intention of continuing and improving the delivery of swimming and water safety education programs. This rebate has subsidised the Swimming Event and as a result there will be no charge for students in Year 3 and 4. There will however be a cost involved for the Year 5 students, as their allocation was deducted from the Beach program costs earlier in the year. The cost for Year 5 students is **\$ 28.00 per child** and is covered by the excursion levy. **Please return the Swimming Preference and Ability form ASAP (by Monday, 15th November) to ensure students get race preferences and are grouped according to ability as much as possible.**

Students will require bathers, a towel, sunscreen, hat, snack, lunch, water bottle and to wear their HOUSE Colours. Even though there is no payment required it is essential that we still receive **your permission form by Thursday, 18th November, 2021**. We are unable to accept late permission forms.

Unfortunately this year we are unable to have parent spectators however we are hoping that next year we will be able to invite our whole community to attend.

Important information to note:

Receiving a ribbon does not automatically qualify students for District Swimming – times will be calculated by Mrs McLaughlin and students advised if applicable.

Student Behaviour

‘I understand that in the event of my child’s misbehaviour or behaviour that poses a danger to himself/herself or others during the excursion, he/she may be sent home. Student accident insurance and ambulance cover

The Department of Education does not provide student accident insurance or ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain student accident insurance from a commercial insurer and/or ambulance cover, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations.

Contract Tracing

Some excursion venues are required to collect contact details and are responsible for managing record keeping for contract-tracing in line with current public health directives.

Most venues are required to use electronic record keeping that connects with an Application Programming Interface (API) linked provider or a digital system provided by Services Victoria.

The Department of Health has **strongly recommended** that a contact number for each individual student is provided. A school phone number alone is not considered sufficient. Providing contact details for individual students will expedite contact tracing so that individuals can be contacted by the Department of Health if required.

Parents/carers/guardians are advised that, when required, the school will be providing excursion venues with contact details for students. The phone number on school file for the student will be provided as the nominated contact number.

Venues will be collecting student names and contact phone numbers for a legitimate purpose and are subject to Victorian privacy laws so will handle the information securely and only retain it for the required 28-day period.
