

**YEAR 6 ACMI EXCURSION –THE STORY OF THE MOVING IMAGE
AUSTRALIAN MUSIC VAULT
THURSDAY, 20TH OCTOBER, 2022**

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Inquiry this term is called 'Express Yourself' and it is an exciting adventure into the world of entertainment. Students form themselves into musical groups with their classmates and become ready to take on the world.

We will visit ACMI – the centrepiece exhibition: The Story of the Moving Image. Students will discover how inventors, innovators and artists have used light and shadow, time and movement, colour and sound over time to tell stories and celebrate the wonder of the moving image.

There are five distinct sections that frame the major moments in moving image history including: the origins and future of cinema, production design and the creative process, Australian culture and stories, the rise of videogames, and how screens inform, influence and empower us.

We will also visit the Arts Centre Melbourne to see the Australian Music Vault. This is a celebration of the Australian contemporary music story – past, present and future.

It's a place to explore your love of music, revisit some of the big music moments of your life and discover the exciting new stories of today's Australian music scene.

The cost of this excursion is \$7.00 and is included in the excursion levy. The form and money are due back by Friday, 14th October. No late forms or payments can be accepted.

Students will travel to the city by train and need to be at Frankston Train station by **8.30am**. **All students need to be taken by private car to Frankston Station and accompanied by a parent/carer onto the platform. Parents/carers will need to collect and sign off students from the Station Car Park (opposite TAFE) at 4.30 pm.**

FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM MUST BE WORN ON THE DAY. They will need to bring a small backpack, disposable drinks, playlunch and lunch.

We will require 2 parents per grade to help us on this day. If you are interested could you please indicate on the attached form. Please note all parent helpers must provide a copy of their current Working with Children Check.

Student Behaviour
