## FINAL NOTICE FOR CAMP MANYUNG YEAR 3 CAMP 2022

Dear Parents/Carers and Year 3 students,

Please find below some important information about our Year 3 camp to Camp Manyung. Please note that if you have not already paid the **final balance payment of \$145.00 this is due by Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> November. Please see the attached forms (Medical, Dietary and Student Agreement) and packing list.**

Camp Manyung is located on Sunnyside Rd in Mt Eliza and we are asking that parents please drop off and pick up their child from camp. Parents are to use Gate 1 which is the first entry way for Camp Manyung. Arrangements can be made for families to carpool if necessary, however, you must inform your classroom teacher in writing via email, of who is responsible for dropping off and/or collecting your child prior to the camp.

**Drop Off – Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> December between 9:00-9:15am via Gate 1**

**Pick Up – Tuesday, 20<sup>th</sup> December between 1:00-1:15pm via Gate 1**

All medications should be handed to our First Aid teacher Ms Nicole Chester who will be waiting at the small car park and drop off area at Camp Manyung. This medication should be in a **clearly named** plastic bag with **dosage required** and any other special instructions. If you have any queries regarding your child's medication, please contact the school office. Students who require asthma medication should have their asthma puffers with them at all times. Please carry asthma inhalers in a small bag or pouch.

Students will be spending the night in ensuite cabins in groups of up to 7. These will be monitored regularly by staff and we have staff cabins intermittently between cabins. Sleeping arrangements will be based on student preference and teacher judgement. If you have any queries, please contact your classroom teacher.

**Just a friendly reminder that there are to be no** smart watches (eg space talk), money, electronic toys, game consoles, music players, mobile phones or iPads to be brought on camp. If discovered, these items will be confiscated and returned at the end of the camp and families will be notified.
