Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade One students,

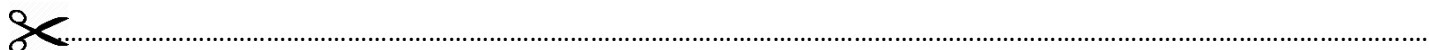
