Chicken Pox

In the past few weeks we have had a number of cases of chicken pox reported to the school. If your child is feeling unwell and has spots or small blisters, no matter how many, it would be advisable to have them checked by a medical professional. As a rule chicken pox is not a serious virus but can be uncomfortable.

Children should be excluded from school until fully recovered or for at least 5 days after the blisters first appear. Note that some remaining scabs are not a reason for continued exclusion.
